Application Period: January 1 ~ March 31 ●

Scope of Curriculum

1. Students require a minimum of 30 credits including Nursing Theory (2 credits), Research Methodology (3 credits), Advanced Applied Biostatistics (3 credits), Health Assessment for Advanced Practice Nursing (3 credits), Transcultural Nursing I (3 credits), Transcultural Nursing II (3 credits), Transcultural Nursing Field Experience (3 credits), elective courses (4 credits), Thesis (6 credits).
2. Students will earn “Master of Science (major in nursing)” degree from College of Nursing after two-year program is successfully completed.

Qualification

Eligibility for application is limited to students who:

1. Do not have overseas Chinese status and do not hold a R.O.C. (Taiwan) passport at least for past eight years.
 2. Have a bachelor's degree or associate degree in fields related to nursing or midwifery from foreign universities and colleges approved by R.O.C. (Taiwan) Ministry of Education.
- ※ Applicants from countries where English is not the native language, or those who have completed their bachelor's degree at a non-English speaking academic institution, are required to have evidence of English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL computer-based test (CBT) score of 173 (or a paper-test score of 500/ iBT score of 61) or higher.

1. Application form
2. Diploma and transcript
3. NTUNHS Medical Report (including an HIV test)
4. Two letters of recommendation
5. Study plan
6. Evidence of English proficiency (English proficiency test certificate or recommendation by Taiwan Embassy)
7. Autobiography and other supporting materials

※ All application forms and relevant documents must be submitted to National Taipei University of Nursing and Health Sciences (NTUNHS) before March 31st.

※ Applicant need to submit official transcript & diploma to R.O.C. (Taiwan) Embassy or Representative Office for authentication after being accepted by NTUNHS.

Scholarship Application

1. Taiwan ICDF Scholarship: Online application form should be filled at Taiwan ICDF Scholarship Programs Online Application System, and relevant documents must be submitted to R.O.C.
