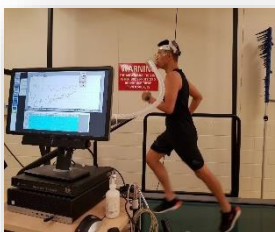
INTRODUCTION OF NTUNHS

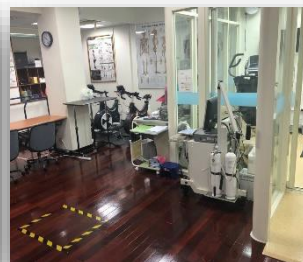
INTRODUCTION OF PROGRAM

SCOPE OF CURRICULUM

1. Students require a minimum of 30 credits including Research Methodology (3 credits), Independent Study (3 credits), and Master Thesis (6 credits) for required subject.

QUALIFICATION

1. Have a bachelor's degree or associate degree in fields related to sport sciences or physical education from foreign universities and colleges approved by R.O.C. (Taiwan) Ministry of Education.
2. Do not have overseas Chinese status and do not hold a R.O.C. (Taiwan) passport at least for past eight years.

** Applicants from countries where English is not the native language, or those who have completed their bachelor's degree at a non-English speaking academic institution, are required to have evidence of English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL IBT test score of 46 or IELTS 5.5 or CEFR B2 Vantage higher.*

APPLICATION

Application Period: January 1- July 31

English Documents required

1. NTUNHS Application Form & NTUNHS Medical Report
2. College diploma/ certificate & all college-level official transcripts
3. Three letters of recommendation
4. Study plan/ statement of purpose/ research goals
5. Evidence of English proficiency (official TOEFL or IELTS score report)
6. CV/ Resume and other supporting materials
7. Passport biographical page
8. Financial statement (A document of financial support with a minimum balance of USD 2,000 or TWD 60,000 is required. or proof of full scholarship provided by a government agency, university)
9. Writing sample (manuscripts, thesis, report, publication...)



**Both paper and online application are accepted.*

***Applicants should upload all the required documents to 1) NTUNHS online application site, 2) e-mail to international center (ntunhs.admission@gmail.com) or 3) post it to school address. Moreover, applicants should make sure all documents are not illegible or blurry.*

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

1. Taiwan Scholarship: Application forms and relevant documents must be submitted to R.O.C. (Taiwan) Embassy or Representative Office before July 31st. (<https://tafs.mofa.gov.tw/>)
2. NTUNHS Scholarship and non-scholarship applicants: Application forms and relevant materials must be submitted to the Office of International Affairs Division, NTUNHS before April 30. (<https://reurl.cc/GXeNWp>).
