PROGRAM INTRODUCTION:

This program was founded in 2018. Courses emphasize diverse training in information management, health care management, long-term care, leisure health, as well as speech language pathology and audiology. The program cultivates professionals, providing students with the abilities and background they need to take advantage of international opportunities.



SCOPE OF CURRICULUM:

Students are required to complete a minimum of 30 credits including the following required courses: Research Methods and Design in Information Management, Seminar on Health Technology, Advanced Applied Statistics, Problem Solving and Decision Making in Healthcare, Independent Study, and Thesis Writing.

Students will earn the **Master of Science** degree from the College of Health Technology after successfully completing the two-year program.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicants are expected to have completed a bachelor's degree in fields related to science or management from universities and colleges approved by the R.O.C. (Taiwan) Ministry of Education.
2. Applicants cannot have held an R.O.C. (Taiwan) passport in the past eight years or have Overseas Chinese status.



APPLICATION: (Application period: January 1 to March 31, 2018)

A complete application must include:

1. The NTUNHS Application Form or a copy of the printed Online Application Form (NTUNHS Online Application: <http://icsed.ntunhs.edu.tw/>)
2. NTUNHS Health Examination Report
3. College diploma or certificate and all official college-level transcripts
4. Two letters of recommendation
5. Study plan or research goals (statement of purpose)
6. Evidence of English proficiency (official TOEFL or IELTS score report)
7. CV or Resume and other supporting materials
8. Passport biographical page
9. Financial Statement (requirement waived for scholarship recipients)
10. All application forms and relevant documents must be posted to National Taipei University of Nursing and Health Sciences (NTUNHS) before March 31. Late submissions will not be accepted.

✘ After being accepted by NTUNHS, applicants need to submit official certificates or diplomas, transcripts and financial statements to the R.O.C. (Taiwan) Embassy or Representative Office for authentication.

APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

(Applicants can apply for any of these scholarships, but they may receive only one at time.)

1. Taiwan Scholarship: Application forms and relevant documents must be submitted to R.O.C. (Taiwan) Embassy or Representative Office before March 31. (<https://goo.gl/bzj72L>)
2. NTUNHS Scholarship: Application forms and relevant materials must be submitted to NTUNHS after being accepted. (<http://goo.gl/4VuynY>).
3. Elite Scholarship Program (ESP): Applicants must applying through two website, both the ESIT website (<https://www.esit.org.tw>) for scholarship and NTUNHS (<http://icsed.ntunhs.edu.tw/>) for admission . Documents must also be submitted to both.
