foreign universities and colleges approved by R.O.C. (Taiwan) Ministry of Education, with a		
minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or its equivalent.		
2.Applicants from countries where English is not the native language, or those who have		
completed their bachelor's degree at a non-English speaking academic institution, are		
required to have evidence of English proficiency equivalent to TOFEL iBT test score of 79, or		
IELTS 6.5 or higher, or a PTE score of at least 53.		
3. A course-by-course evaluation from any NACES (National Association of Credential Evaluation		
Services) approved foreign transcript evaluation company.		
4. Foreign students should carefully read the MOE Regulations "Regarding International Students		
Undertaking Studies in Taiwan" for application eligibility.
