The graduation requirement credits 30 credits.





About Qualifications and Application

Qualifications

- 1. Have a bachelor's degree or associate degree in fields related to nursing or midwifery from foreign universities and colleges approved by R.O.C. (Taiwan) Ministry of Education.
- 2.Applicants from countries where English is not the native language, or those who have completed their bachelor's degree at a non-English speaking academic institution, are required to have evidence of English proficiency equivalent to TOFEL iBT test score of 46 or IELTS 5.5 or CEFR B2 Vantage or higher.
- 3. Foreign students should carefully read the MOE Regulations "Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan" for application eligibility.
